Ambitious Academy Trust Leader Takes on New Responsibility for Teaching & Learning of 30,000 students in Yorkshire

The White Rose Academies Trust is proud to announce that Mr Andrew Whitaker has been promoted to a new role as Deputy CEO – Teaching and Learning, Luminate Education Group and CEO of the White Rose Academies Trust.

Since joining the White Rose Academies Trust in September 2016, Andrew has helped to turn the Trust's three secondary academies from 'Special Measures' into 'Good' schools, welcomed the Trust's first primary school (Mill Field Primary Academy), and formulated a partnership with education consultancy High Performance Learning to bring a world class level of education to Leeds.

Over four years later, the Trust has transformed these schools into some of the most improved secondary schools in the region and has expanded, welcoming Mill Field Primary Academy in December 2020.

As CEO of the Trust, Andrew is determined that all White Rose Academies will become world class providers of education to the communities that they serve by 2025. As a way of ensuring this, the Trust has formed a partnership with High Performance Learning, an educational consultancy whose fundamental belief that every student can become a 'high-performer' is backed by thirty years of research and practice.

In 2018, Andrew was awarded a prestigious Churchill Fellowship and as part of this he will be researching the work of the Charter School movement in the United States.
